

## Extension to the Period for Responses to the Consultation on Measures in support of the retail market

## 22 April 2021

The Commission has published on 2 April 2021 a <u>consultation</u> document setting out proposals to support non-household customers affected by the pandemic and transition the market back to its normal operations. The document also sets out plans to introduce a new licence condition on financial resilience measures.

The Commission invited stakeholders to provide their comments on the consultation document and set out an initial deadline for comments of 23 April 2021. To ensure that all stakeholders have sufficient time to consider the proposals and contribute constructively throughout the consultation process we have now extended the deadline to 7 May 2021.

The Commission will also arrange a workshop to provide stakeholders with an opportunity to discuss the proposals and seek clarification. The details for the workshop will follow separately.
